The Tibor Varga, Carl Flesh, Lady Barbirolli, William Kapell, and Gina Bachaeur International Competitions are a just few of the awards that they have earned over the years. They have also soloed with the Chicago, Berlin Radio and Baltimore Symphony Orchestras, and have been active chamber musicians as members of the Lincoln and the Seraphin Trios. Ms. Desiree Ruhstrat and Mr. David Cunliffe are faculty members at the Music Institute of Chicago. Prof. Myung Hee Chung is the head of the Keyboard Program at the University of Wisconsin - Whitewater.

Hyun Chung Kim, Sojung Hong, and Jeong Soo Kim are all alumni of the Seoul National University in Korea. Prof. Hong and Prof. J.S. Kim, who teach at Judson University and Northern Illinois University, respectively, received their doctorate degrees from the University of Illinois and the Eastman School of Music. Hyun Chung Kim will be performing a traditional Korean solo on the Korean bamboo flute, also known as the Dae Geum. The piece is meant to depict the serenity of an autumn evening.
